Some pointers to speed things up

- Please submit your plan on the Word template along with the WMP submission pro-forma.
- The submission pro-forma is for CS funded plans only.
- Available on FC website.
- Plans should be sent to FC admin hubs but good idea to copy WO into email.

- Complete the 6 point UKFS criteria checklist to show you have considered these.
- Consider all the threats. E.g, Deer, climate change and state what you are going to do in more detail than, "Monitor".
- Consider other CS funded requirements as a useful aide-memoir (although the tail should not wag the dog!)
- In section 4.1 Description, its helpful to understand with more complex woods, the present species breakdown and your species changes in the Plan of Ops to diversify under UKFS

- Use section 6 Management Strategy in the plan to spell out your objectives and delivery.
- Use the latest Plan of Ops template. On existing versions (that are currently in progress) please leave the grey example lines untouched.
- Each row will need a cmpt number.
- Remember to complete the restocking for FC/NR and any OG.
- Consider splitting rows for cpts if thin and felling are required on one area.

- Please ensure we have at least one map where the compartment boundaries are clear.
- Labels don't mask features or boundary lines!
- Is every symbol shown on the map, explained in the legend and vice versa?
- Do you need to show everything on one map?
- Consider the use of Design concept maps for larger or very diverse woodlands
- Where relevant, elevations can be very useful to demonstrate how plans look in the landscape.



- For some plans it may be acceptable to leave this section blank although this will be rare.
- Do all your formal consultation first and don't leave it to the FC (SSSI, SAC, NP, HE, AONB etc)
- Consider using Parish Councils, as a way to have a better informed public generally.
- The ideal scenario is one where the submitted plan has had all stakeholder engagement completed.

Stakeholder Engagement

- Although this exercise can seem onerous, it is a fantastic tool to counter future complaints.
- Suggest that consultation letters state, "if I do not hear from your within 28 days, I will assume you do not wish to comment"
- Our role is to support you when you get negative responses or rejections.
