

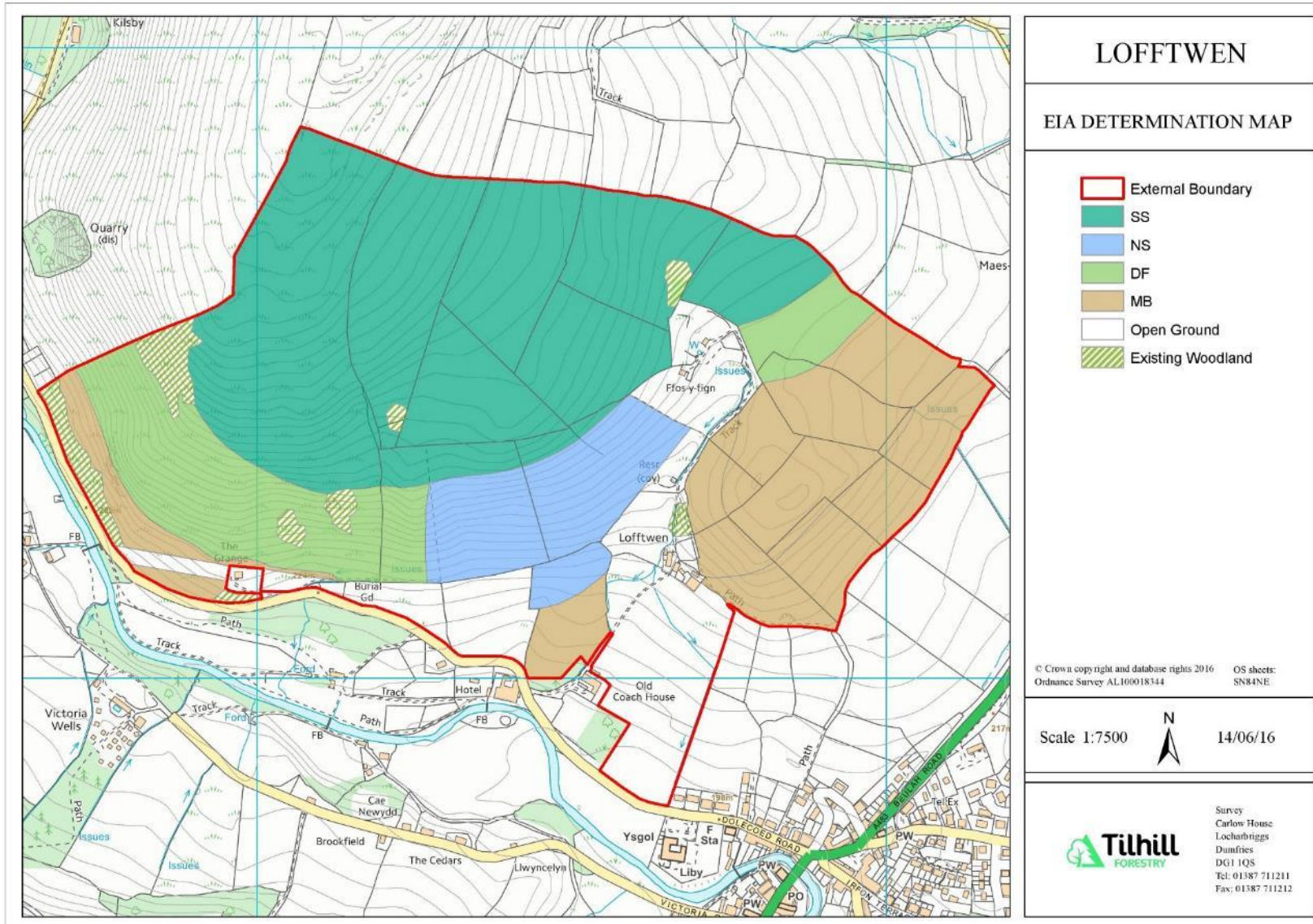

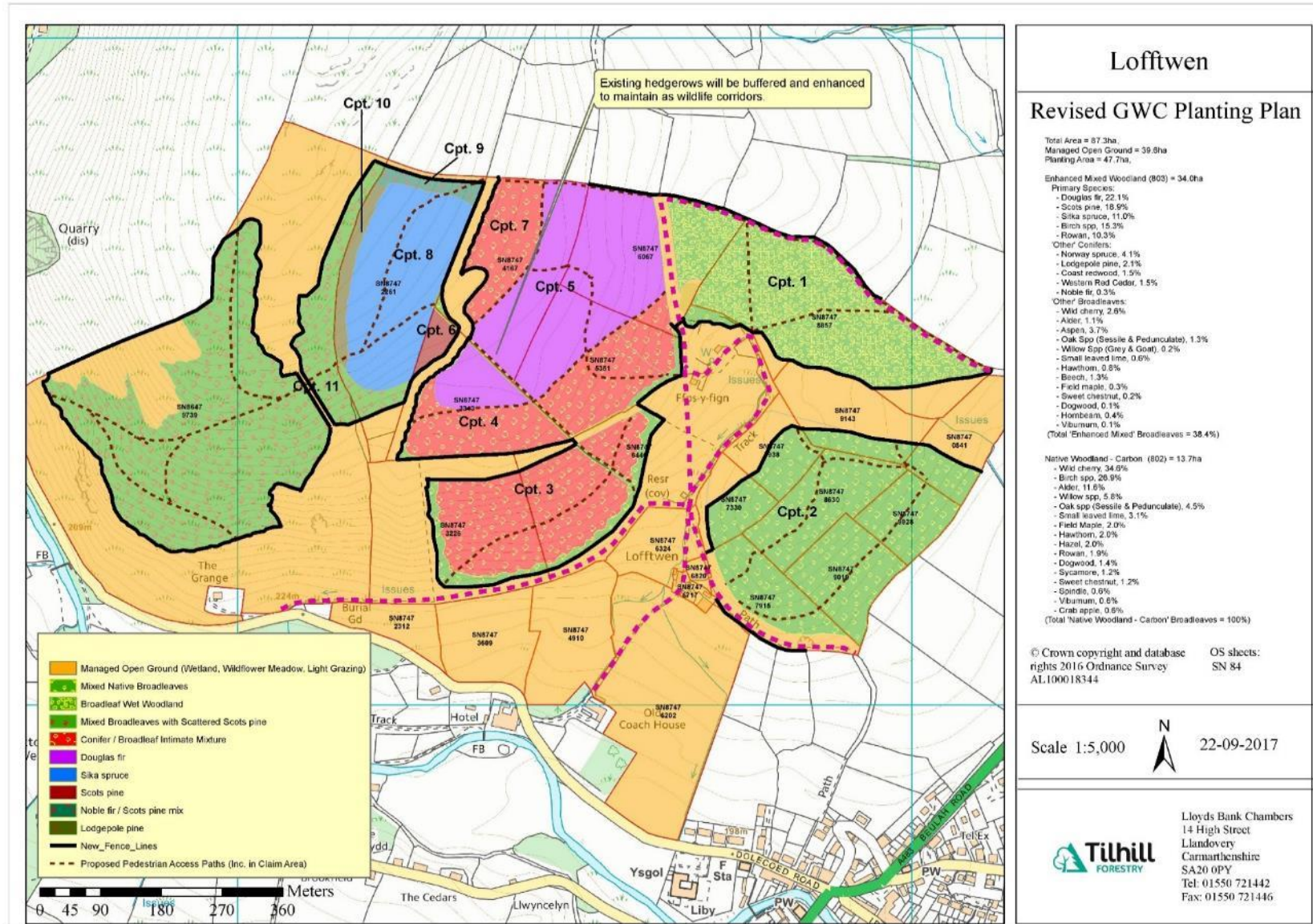


# Initial EIA Determination

- Afforestation will result in irretrievable loss of farm land
- Plans will negatively impact tourism in the area
- No local employment benefits
- Increased traffic through Llanwrtyd during future forest operations
- Belief that Lofftwen had been bought by a 'development company'
