You will liaise with Natural Resources Wales colleagues and a range of external stakeholders.

Frequent travel across Wales is required. A full driving licence is beneficial however we may consider other options or methods of travel proposed from candidates.

### You will be able to demonstrate knowledge and experience of the following:

- Knowledge of: Welsh, UK and EU legislation related to forestry land management and agriculture; Welsh, UK Government policy drivers in land management including forestry and agriculture as set out in the Welsh Government's Glastir programme; and the issues and opportunities in Wales.

- Working with/in Welsh Government, across the forestry sector and other land management organisations.
